

PLAYERS

JASON BUTTLESM.H.S. 1989-1992

There are not many 3 sport decorated athletes that have come through Manhasset as Jason Buttles. As a football, wrestling, and lacrosse team member, Jason enjoyed 3 varsity letters for football and wrestling, earning All-Conference honors as a junior and All-County honors as a senior in football. He earned similar awards for wrestling, in addition to having the best ever placement in Manhasset; 2nd in Nassau County, at 177lbs. Jason was, however, a 4 year Varsity member of the lacrosse team, and was a definitive player on the 1991 Nassau County finalist team. He was named All-American his senior year, and served as Captain of the team his junior and senior years, as he did for wrestling and football. As a true leader of 3 different sports at Manhasset, Jason went on to play lacrosse at Princeton University, where he was a member of a Final Four team, as early as his freshman year. Princeton went on to win the National Championship his sophomore and senior years.

His love for lacrosse allowed him to pursue post-collegiate lacrosse for the LA Riptide and is presently an active member of the Marin Lacrosse Club. Jason and his wife, Lele, live in Kentfield, California with their son, Otto. They are most excited to return to Manhasset tonight and enjoy this great event with family and friends!



ROGER BUTTLES M.H.S. 1993-1996

Roger Buttles was one of the finest athletes to have graced the fields at Manhasset. As a 3 sport, highly decorated athlete, Roger was a member of the Varsity Football team for three years, and was named All-County and was an integral part of the County Championship team his junior year. During the winter months, he found himself in the wrestling room working on discipline, conditioning, and strength which certainly carried over to his 4 year varsity lacrosse history while at Manhasset. Roger was a member of the 1995 State Championship team, as an outstanding attack player. As a sophomore, he was recognized as an All-County player, and as a junior, Honorable Mention All-American, and then ultimately was named All-American as a senior. He was a member of the Gold-winning Empire State Team in 1995. Senior year, he was co-captain while at Manhasset, as a leader on and off the field. Roger went on to play at Harvard University, and as a sophomore was honored as 2nd team All-Ivy, and All-New England, and was the team MVP. Junior year, he was recognized as an Honorable Mention All-American, and 1st team All-Ivy, and All-New England. As a senior, Roger was a pre-season Tewaaraton Award finalist. Coach Scott Anderson recognized him as "a leader, and always a threat."

Roger has just recently moved back to New York as an artist and is looking forward to his imminent marriage to Meghan Doherty, MD.

M.H.S. 2002-2005


As a 10 Varsity sport athlete, Meg Clarke's performance was nothing less than outstanding during each season she competed while at Manhasset. As a varsity soccer player for 3 years, Meg was decorated with an All-Conference award her sophomore year and All-County awards her Junior and Senior years. During the winter season, Meg was found in the gym shooting hoops. As a 4 year Varsity basketball player, Meg is one of the 7 girls that achieved over 1,000 career points. She was team captain for three years, and among her many awards, was a two-time All-State player, Barbara Hoffman Tournament MVP, and was named player of the year for Conference V her junior year.

Her career in lacrosse is just as impressive. Playing for Coach Campelettano, she matched her awards received in soccer, being named All-Conference her sophomore year, and awarded All-County honors her Junior and Senior year. Her accomplishments were not only felt personally, but were also recognized through team accomplishments. No doubt, that was the run of State Achievements, sophomore year, State Champions and Junior and Senior years, State Championship finalist. Coach Rule says that Mike was among "the most tenacious and hard working young men that I have had the opportunity to coach." The "Manhasset Plan" worked for Mike, as after playing two JV years, then starting his Junior and Senior years, he was then named an All-American player his last year. Manhasset High School proved to be just a stepping stone for Mike, as he immediately, post-graduation, was a member of the Empire State team, and also was a member of the USA Under 19 World Team, which went on to win the Gold in Australia! Mike was also a 2 year, All-Conference Captain of the soccer team while at Manhasset. Mike went on to play at Duke University under the direction of Mike Presler, as a 4 year member of the team, he was named team captain, was an All-Academic out of the ACC, and was a key player while Duke won 2 ACC championships. Mike attributes all he learned while playing lacrosse with his success at the NYPD, where he is presently a Sergeant. PATTI ANNE KENNY REILLY M.H.S. 1983-1986

No other player to grace the fields during the many years of Manhasset Girls' Lacrosse could have been more athletic and effortless while playing, than Patti Anne Kenny. Her speed and tenacity as a defensive midfielder (wing.) made her a key player on the 1985 State Championship team. Her role of maintaining an opposing team's top player, earned her an All-State player her senior year. She was a leader and role model on and off the field, and was named Captain her senior year.

Patti Anne was recruited to UMASS Amherst to play lacrosse, however, chose her passion of dance, and was granted a 4 year talent award to fulfill her deepest love of performing, teaching, and choreographing. She received the "Best Emerging Choreographer" from the Pennsylvania Council for the Arts in 1996.

She has spent several years in the Parsons Dance Company, as well as on Broadway, and is presently the Artistic Director of the Patricia Kenny Dance Collection since 2001.

As a member of a true "lacrosse family." Patti Anne joins her sister, Christine, as a Hall of Fame member. She prides herself as a "backyard coach" to her three children, Meghan, Brendan, and Brian, and is presently a board member of the PAL. Patti Anne joins her husband, Tim (2014), as the first husband and wife honorees of the Manhasset Lacrosse Hall of Fame.

GAVIN J. PETRACCA M.H.S. 2002-2005

As a highly honored lacrosse player while at Manhasset, Gavin Petracca, as a freshman was recognized as one of the finest players to come through Manhasset in recent years. Gavin was a 4 year attack starter, and received the first All-Conference award his first year, and subsequently received that award each of the following years, as well as All-County the following three years, and was an All-American his senior year, as well as being named the Nassau County "Attackman of the Year." As a junior, Gavin played on the Long Island Empire Team and as a silver medalist, was the leading scorer. There is no doubt that Gavin was a team player and his sound performance allowed Manhasset to achieve huge team finishes during his 4 year tenure. As a sophomore, Manhasset won the Long Island Championship, as a junior, undefeated, New York State Champions, and #1 National Ranking, and as a senior, were the NYS Finalist team and Long Island Champions.

Gavin was recruited to University of North Carolina where he again was a 4 year starter, and contributor to a program that is nationally recognized. He was named to the ACC Academic Honor Roll, two time ESPN's "Top Ten Plays of the Week," was a three time ACC Lacrosse Player of the Week and graduated UNC as a Top 10 Point Scorer in the scchool's history, and was named UNC's Lacrosse MVP in 2010.

Certainly Petracca is synonymous with lacrosse, and Gavin's biggest fan is looking over his family from the greenest lacrosse field ever originated. We miss you, Mike, and couldn't be happier for Gavin!
