#### **HARVEY COHEN**

Harvey Cohen has spent over 40 years developing young men at every level in the game of lacrosse. From junior lacrosse to the World Games, Harvey has always been there to offer any help he could. As a graduate of Lafayette College, he played freshman football, Varsity football, soccer and lacrosse. In 1941, he played for the Boston Lacrosse Club and was a volunteer assistant coach of the Harvard Freshman Lacrosse Team.

Harvey is the founder of the Long Island Metropolitan Lacrosse Foundation. He was inducted into the Long Island Lacrosse Hall of Fame in 1986. He was also inducted into the National Lacrosse Hall of Fame in 1988. In 2001, the Port Washington Youth Activities (PYA) named the Lions Field Facility the "Harvey Cohen Field." In 2004, he received the Howdy Myers Man of the Year Award from the U.S. Intercollegiate Lacrosse Association.

A graduate of Harvard Law School and an attorney since 1948, Harvey has been a partner in the law firm of Murtagh, Cohen & Byrne to the present date. Harvey has been married to his wife Norma for over 60 years. They have three children, six grandchildren, and two step-grandchildren.

## **KEYIN HEALY**

M.H.S. 1992—1995

Kevin Healy was a three year varsity goalie at Manhasset High School where he was voted captain of the team in 1995 and earned All-American Honors. 1995 was an outstanding year for Kevin as he was chosen one of the Top 10 Players on Long Island. That year he lead the team to a state championship and was named the State Championship Defensive Player of the Game.

Kevin graduated from the University of Maryland in 1999. In 1998, he achieved a number of accolades including ACC Player of the Year, while being voted a 2nd Team All-American. He was a member of the All ACC Team in both 1998 and 1999 and played in the All ACC Tournament in 1998. Not just a great athlete, but Kevin had the brains to match, as he was named to the ACC Honor Roll for 1997-98 and the ACC Academic Honor Roll for 1998-99. Kevin ranked #7 for All Time Saves for 1997-99 with 383 saves. His single season record was 14 in 1998 for Most Wins.



While Janine attended Manhasset High School she distinguished herself athletically all four years. She was an outstanding athlete playing and competing in field hockey, basketball, volleyball, softball, and lacrosse. In 1979, the first Manhasset Girls Varsity Lacrosse Team was formed. Janine was not only a key founding member, but her leadership qualities were recognized by her teammates when she was elected captain.

Janine went on to SUNY Cortland and was a two sport Varsity athlete playing field hockey and lacrosse from 1980-84. As co-captain of the lacrosse team during her senior year, she helped lead the team to the 1984 championship game. During the same year, she held the school record for most career goals. Additionally, Janine was named State Player both her junior and senior years.

Janine has also distinguished herself academically. She received her doctorate in audiology in 2004 and has been working for the Department of Veteran's Affairs for the New York Healthcare Harbor System as an audiologist since 1988. She has also been an Adjunct Assistant Professor for CUNY-Brooklyn College since 1993.

#### **JOHN KEOGH** M.H.S. 1979—1982

John was a great leader on the lacrosse field at Manhasset where he was a three year varsity starter. He earned all County honors as an attackman his jr. and sr. year while being voted captain his sr. year in 1982.

John attended Brown University where he was an All Ivy League attack man for three years. He was the third leading all-time scorer in Brown's history at time of graduation in 1986. John, showing his leadership skills again was also chosen captain of the 1986 men's lacrosse team. John showed his great athletic ability by also being a 4 year starter for Brown's Varsity football team.

John currently resides in Manhasset with his wife Lauren and their three daughters. He is currently coaching in the Manhasset P.A.L. girls' lacrosse program.

#### ROBERT SERLING M.H.S. 1975—1978

Robert Serling was a great team player while at Manhasset. As an attackman he not only knew how to find the goal but prided himself in finding his teammates with assisted goals as well. He was a member of the All County team in 1978 when the team was ranked #1 in the state. Robert led the team in points (goals and assists) that year and also was chosen to play in the High School North/South All Star Game.

Robert attended Ithaca College from 1979-82. He was voted an All-American in 1982. He continues to hold Ithaca College records with 120 career assists, 46 assists in one season, and 3.2 assists per game average per season. He played in the North/South Senior All Star game in 1982 with 2 assists to Manhasset classmate Harry Jackson from WestPoint.

Over the years, Robert has volunteered a great deal of his time to coaching lacrosse. He started in 1992 with two years at Lynbrook PAL. From 1998-2008 he has coached the Rockville Centre PAL where he coached the first boys' team in 1994. He has been coaching the girls' lacrosse team for the past four years.

Robert is owner/manager of Quality Metal Stamping LLC in Rockville Centre, New York. He is the proud father of three boys and one girl, who coincidentally, all play lacrosse.

#### **ARIANA TADLER**

M.H.S. 1982-1985

Born in Queens, New York, Ariana Tadler had no exposure to the sport of lacrosse until she and her family moved to Manhasset in 1976. It wasn't until she was in middle school that a friend encouraged her to pick up a lacrosse stick and give it a try. Uniquely left-handed, Ariana was the starting goalie throughout her entire lacrosse career; first, as a member of the Junior Varsity team while a student at Manhasset Junior High School and then as a member of the Varsity Lacrosse team for Manhasset High School where Pam Monfort was her coach. Tough and unrelenting, Pam demanded the very best from her team, teaching both skills and life lessons. Ariana recalls Pam insisting that she run the same drills as the rest of the team, but with the weight and burden of the goalie gear. Nonetheless, the hard work paid off. In 1985, Manhasset High School's Girls' Varsity Lacrosse Team won the New York State Championship.

Ariana was recruited by several colleges but ultimately declined them in order to attend Hamilton College. While at Hamilton, Ariana played lacrosse during her freshman and sophomore years and was a starting goalie. During her junior year, Ariana moved to London where she met her husband, David Paterson.

Today, Ariana is a managing partner at a major New York law firm where she specializes in securities and consumer law. She is also an accredited speaker on e-discovery. Ariana credits her career success in large part to those who pushed her to the limit to be the very best – people like Pam Monfort and others at Manhasset High School. Oh, and of course, there's that friend who introduced Ariana to the sport of lacrosse, Danielle Gallagher.


