At Manhasset, Tom played first Mid-Field on teams that won a Long Island Championship and a Nassau County Championship. Tom played his college ball at Harvard and his leadership qualities paid off as he was elected Captain in his senior year. Tom returned to Manhasset and has continued his association with the game by imparting his knowledge and skills to so many young boys as a coach in the PAL program.

Bob Rule......Manhasset HS 1966-67

Bob is one of the finest goalies the game has ever known. He was an all county goalie on the Indians 1967 Long Island Championship team. He was voted the game MVP in the Nassau County final. Bob attended Cornell University and was a three year starter for the Big Red. He played on the first National Championship team in 1971. He was also the recipient of the C. Markland Kelly award as the Nation's best goaltender. Bob was also named to the 1974 USA team and was the starting goalie for the World Champions. Bob has served as Manhasset HS defensive coach for the past 17 years. He was elected to the Cornell University Hall of Fame in 1987, the Long Island Hall of Fame in 1988 and now the big one.

Barney Fields...... Manhasset HS 1973-76

Barney was a three year starter for the Indians from 1974-76. He was the offensive leader on two Nassau County Championship teams. He also was the team captain in '76. Barney attended John Hopkins University and was a member on two NCAA Championship teams. Barney returned to Manhasset and has continued his association with Lacrosse by sharing his skills, spirit and enthusiasm with the young players of Manhasset as a coach in the PAL program.
